1. CALL TO ORDER BY SCLRC CHAIRMAN, Alex Zumbar

2. ROLL CALL – Board Members Present

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 19, 2022 AND SEPTEMBER 27, 2022 MEETING

Zumbar stated approval of the minutes of September 19th is deferred due to Arnold not being present, and the other members here today were not present for that meeting. Zumbar moved and Creighton seconded to approve the minutes of September 27, 2022 meeting. Motion carried on a roll call vote as follows: Voting Aye - Zumbar, Creighton, and Smith

Creighton moved and Smith seconded to approve the Side Lot/Vacant Lot report as presented. Motion carried on a roll call vote as follows: Voting Aye - Zumbar, Creighton, and Smith

7. NEW BUSINESS

- a. Targeted Acquisition Assistance Requests:
 - City of Canton Parcel #10010986 (vacant lot on 30th St.)

Creighton moved and Smith seconded to approve the City of Canton's TAAP request. Motion carried on a roll call vote as follows: Voting Aye - Zumbar, Creighton, and Smith

Habitat for Humanity – Parcel #242873 (2340 21st St. NE)

Smith moved and Creighton seconded to approve Habitat for Humanity's TAAP request. Motion carried on a roll call vote as follows: Voting Aye - Zumbar, Creighton, and Smith

• City of Louisville – Parcel #3605844 (Marion Ave.)

Creighton moved and Smith seconded to approve the City of Louisville's TAAP request. Motion carried on a roll call vote as follows: Voting Aye - Zumbar, Creighton, and Smith

8. OLD BUSINESS

a. City of North Canton – Demolition Assistance Agreement – 407 N. Main St.

Peters stated that North Canton had been approved funding up to \$26,000 for the 407 N. Main Street project. The city had submitted their documentation for the demolition by the October 3rd deadline. During the demolition, the contractor found a basement that they did not know about, and it needed backfilled after the demolition, so the city incurred unexpected costs for work on the project. With the additional cost to backfill the basement, the total project cost came to \$33,626; so at 50% there is the additional cost of \$7,646 above the funding amount the city was approved for. The city has now requested reimbursement of those overages. An addendum would be done to their agreement to fund that additional \$7,646. Smith moved and Creighton seconded to approve the City of North Canton's request for additional funding of \$7,646. Motion carried on a roll call vote as follows: Voting Aye - Zumbar, Creighton, and Smith.

Peters stated with that approval, a budget revision will be needed. A previous budget revision was done to fund exactly the projects that were left to the end of the year. With this approval for additional funds for North Canton, some funds will need to be shifted from a couple line items to accommodate this. This revision would involve taking \$4,000 out of the property maintenance line item, \$2,000 from the marketing line item, and \$1,646 from miscellaneous. Zumbar suggested making an amended budget request at the next meeting.
